HR917 did not receive a hearing during the 2021-22 legislative session, but bill may receive an out-of-session committee hearing. We will wait for advice from colleagues from Gwinnett STOPP and the End Mass Incarceration GA Network on how best to support future efforts related to the bill.

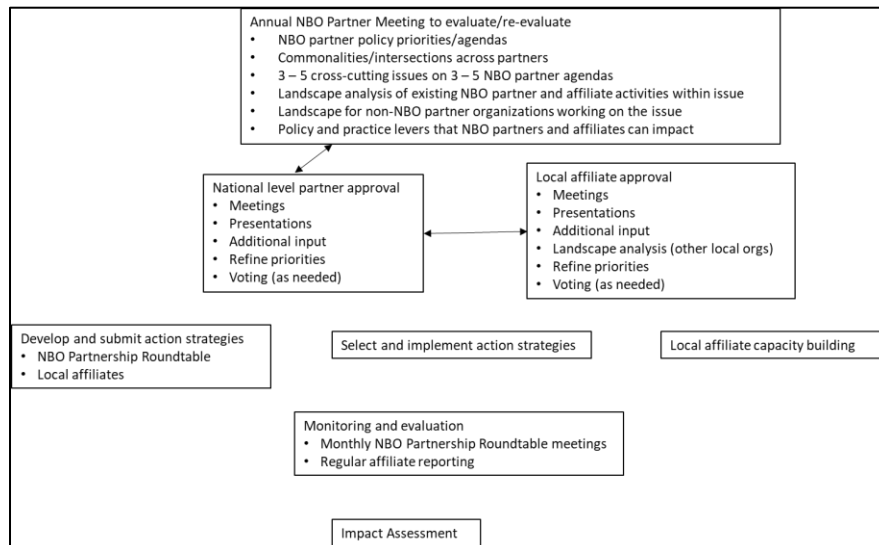
a. Update
